- Additional supporting materials, based on user requests

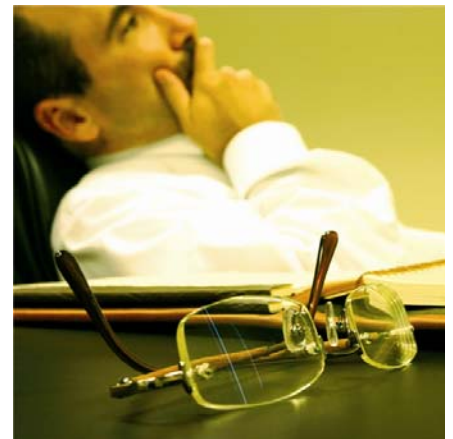
The COBIT® 4.1 Foundation Examination
